

## MB Crusher Buckets working successfully on important Brazil Projects

Vicenza-based company MB's products are being used for important constructions in Brazil ahead of the 2014 World Cup. MB's partnership with Grupo Monte Sinai Locação Ltd, a company specialized in providing various services including renting of machinery and equipment, supply of materials etc began in 2009 between the Group owners, Abinael Manoel and Enoque Manoel De Souza and MB Area Manager for Brazil, Carlotta Mettifogo.

Besides various construction sites, MB's Crusher Buckets and Screening Buckets have been used for the construction of the Arena Pernambuco stadium for 2014 Brazilian World Cup. Explaining the working of MB's products, De Souza says, "We purchased the first BF90.3 in May 2011 and used it for recycling of demolished materials at the 'Atlantico Sul' shipyard in the Port of Suape (Pernambuco). We then took MB Crusher Bucket to the "Shopping Rio Mar" site to crush inert material from the demolition of an old factory, and

this material was subsequently reused at the same site."

"We are really so pleased with the purchase that in January 2012 we bought another model from the range, the BF120.4, and then in March 2012, the Screening Bucket MBS-18, one of the company's newest products," he adds.

Appreciating the product functioning, Mr. De Souza says, "With the MB Crusher Bucket, the great advantage has been that of saving on the cost of materials: instead of buying it from third parties, we used material that came straight from the site, from the demolished construction or from the site ground itself. This has allowed us to make significant savings in terms of materials, resources, our time and the time of the customer who commissioned the work. This shows that the "significant savings" has led to other commissions at the same sites as well as conveying a sense of solid professionalism to our customers. It is worth mentioning here that we use the MB Crusher Bucket for an average of 10

hours a day, 6 days a week. On top of all this, no special maintenance is required; keeping costs low compared to mobile or fixed crushers."

MB products have become important assets in worldwide events. Back in 2010, the company's Bucket Crushers were used to build the Soccer City Stadium ahead of the South African World Cup. After South Africa came Brazil and its Arena Pernambuco, the construction of which was entrusted to the national giant 'Construtora Norberto Odebrecht' who contacted Grupo Monte Sinai to hire MB Bucket Crusher.

Overwhelmed with this response, MB Managing Director, Guido Azzolin says, "Significant investment in research has, allowed MB to produce indispensable and cutting-edge buckets with unparalleled performance.
